SCHOLARSHIP CRITERIA AND AWARD PROCESS

- ▶ Scholarship is available to full-time (12 credits/semester), college students who are currently enrolled in a two-year, four-year or a graduate program and demonstrates a keen interest in pursuing a career in hydrographic surveying or related fields.
- ▶ Applicants must be a citizen or permanent resident of the U.S.
- ▶ Applicants must be enrolled, or accepted in a full-time U.S. college or university with accreditation recognized by the U. S. Department of Education.
- ▶ Applications for the current scholarship award will be accepted between October 22, 2019, and the **deadline of November 15, 2019** (for the school year 2019-2020).
- ▶ Applications will be reviewed by THSOA Scholarship Committee and forwarded with recommendations to THSOA Board of Directors by November 30, 2019.
- ▶ Scholarship should be awarded by December 31, 2019.
- ▶ For 2019-2020 academic year; scholarship awards will be:
 - ▶ 1x \$5000
 - ▶ 3x \$3000
 - ▶ 3x \$2000
- ▶ Selection will be based on a combination of academic performance, letter of recommendation, and answers documented in the application process.
- ▶ Students cannot receive THSOA Chapter and THSOA National scholarship in the same school year.
- ▶ Graduate student(s) selected are expected to submit a technical paper to the 2021 U.S. Hydrographic Conference.
